

PRIVACY POLICY STATEMENT

Millar Company, LLC. ("MCO") takes the protection of our customers' personal information very seriously and we respect your right to privacy. You can generally browse our Web site without providing any personal information; however, you may find fields where we may request a small amount of information. We want to be sure that you are clear about what your information is used for and how it is protected.

This Privacy Statement ("Statement") contains information about privacy as it relates to this web site ("Site"). If you have objections to or do not agree with this Statement, you should not access or use this Site. This Statement does not address, represent, or govern privacy practices associated with offline activities or other MCO web sites. For the purpose of this Statement, "personal information" is defined as any information that identifies or can be used to identify, contact or locate the person to whom such information pertains.

Changes in Privacy Statement

All "personal information" that we collect and maintain shall be subject to the version of the privacy practices in effect at the time of such collection. MCO reserves the right to change the Privacy Statement from time to time at its sole discretion. You will be deemed to have been made aware of, and will be subject to, the changes to the Privacy Statement by your continued use of the Site after a revised Statement has been posted.

If MCO sells assets (or the assets of a division or subsidiary) to another entity, or if MCO (or a division or subsidiary) is acquired by or merged with, another entity, MCO may provide to such entity customer information that is related to that part of our business that was sold to or merged with the other entity without your consent.

Entities Collecting Personal Information

Personal information on this Site is collected by Millar Company, LLC at P.O. Box 695, Cullman, Alabama 35056. Our phone number is (256) 775-1500. The Site contains links to other sites at which personal information is collected. In such instances, the collection and use of your personal information will be governed by the privacy policy of the entity that is collecting your personal information.

Collection of Personal Information

As a visitor to this Site, you can generally browse the Site and engage in many activities without providing any personal information. When accessing other activities, MCO may request certain information through various methods (by phone, submitting an online form, etc.). It is completely optional for you to engage in these activities. If you elect to engage in these activities, MCO may request personal information, such as your first and last name, mailing address (including zip code), e-mail address, company name, job title, telephone and facsimile numbers. When ordering products or services on the Site, you may be asked to provide a credit card number. Depending upon the activity, some information we request is identified as mandatory and some as voluntary. If you do not provide the mandatory data with respect to a particular activity, you will not be able to engage in that activity.

When you use the Site, MCO or third parties authorized by MCO may also collect certain technical and routing information about your computer to facilitate your use of the Site and its services. For example, we may log environmental variables, such as browser type, operating system, CPU speed, and the Internet Protocol ("IP") address of your computer. We use these

environmental variables to facilitate and track your use of the Site and its services. MCO may also use such environmental variables to measure traffic patterns on the Site.

When you submit personal information to MCO through this Site, you understand and agree that this information may be transferred across national boundaries and may be stored and processed in any of the countries in which MCO and its affiliates and subsidiaries maintain offices or store information. You also acknowledge that in certain countries or with respect to certain activities, the collection, transferring, storage and processing of your information may be used by trusted vendors of MCO. One instance where this could occur is in conjunction with framed pages in which the URL for the pages is not visible and the pages are being hosted by a vendor of MCO.

MCO has established relationships with various service providers whose services are available to you from this Site or from web sites that are linked to this Site. Typically, these providers offer services that MCO customers might find useful. In order to use those services, you may be required to provide personal information to the providers. Personal information that you provide shall be governed by the privacy policy of the entity that is collecting your personal information. Any of that information shared with MCO may be used by MCO in a manner consistent with this Statement.

In order to reduce errors in our database, authenticate our users and prevent abuse of our system we may on occasion supplement the personal information you submit to us with information from third party sources. For example, we may supplement your registration information with address information provided by the U.S. Postal Service to qualify your information and prevent errors in our database.

How your Personal Information is Used

MCO collects your information in order to record and support your participation in the activities you select, to market and sell its products and services, to improve its products and services, and for support of its products and services. Your personal information is also used to keep you informed about product upgrades, special offers, and other products and services of MCO and selected third parties. MCO also collects information about the use of the Site; such as the types of services used and how many users we receive daily. MCO may use this data for statistical analysis, marketing, sales, or similar promotional purposes.

Your Choices with Respect to Personal Information

MCO will provide your personal information to comply with laws or regulations of a governmental or regulatory body or in response to a subpoena, warrant or order or to protect the rights of MCO or others. Otherwise, MCO will not provide your name to other companies or organizations without your consent, except to those companies or organizations performing marketing, sales, or similar promotional purposes for MCO.

Protection of Your Personal Information

Personal information that you provide resides on a secure server that only MCO personnel and contractors have access to via password. Although MCO uses reasonable precautions based on the company's size and information collected, no data collected by any company is completely safe from hackers.

Use of Cookies

When you visit this Site, you can browse the Site and access important information without revealing your identity. In order to improve the Site, MCO may use "cookies" to track your visit. A cookie is a small amount of data that is stored on your computer by a Web server. It

functions as your identification card and enables MCO to record your passwords, purchases, and preferences. It cannot be executed as code or deliver viruses. You can set your browser to notify you when a cookie is received, giving you the option to decide whether or not to accept it.

Updating Your Personal Information and Preferences

You have the right to correct any personal information and modify any privacy preferences that you have provided to us at any time. You may do so in writing.
